

## Archival collections in the Sibelius Museum (2014)

### 1. PRESS ARCHIVE

#### *I Persons*

- Finnish persons A-Ö (59 running metres)
- foreign persons A-Ö (26 RM)

#### *II Locations/Towns*

- Finland A-Ö (76 RM)
- Other countries A-Ö (X RM)

#### *III Other* (in total 42 RM)

- Pop/rock, jazz, folk music, church music, singing festivals, musical associations and organizations, instruments etc.

NB! The press archive is not registered in a catalog (except material related to Sibelius, which is partly registered in the database. (Spegeln/ Document type: "Sibelius Clipping")

### 2. PHOTOGRAPHIC COLLECTION

- approx. 20 000 images, the bulk is found in the database (Spegeln/ Document type: "Bilder")
- The collection contains portraits, but also pictures of orchestras, choirs and other groups.

### 3. CONCERT PROGRAMMES

#### *I Persons* A-Ö (7.5 RM)

#### *II Finland: groups, musical associations etc.* A-Ö (19 RM)

#### *III Domestic music festivals etc.* A-Ö (6 RM)

#### *IV Foreign concert programmes* A-Ö (3 RM)

NB! There is no catalog of the programmes.

### 4. MANUSCRIPTS

#### *I Musical manuscripts* A-Ö (26 RM)

- registered in database (Spegeln/ Document type: "Manuscript")
- sorted according to composer and work

#### *II Handwritten music books* (4.5 RM)

- registered in database (Spegeln/ Document type: "Handskrift")

#### *III Letters* (4 RM)

-registered according to sender and recipient, A-Ö.

- The information is not available online, the staff is happy to provide further information.

### 5. PRINTED MUSIC

#### *I Domestic music* (112.5 RM)

- partly registered in database, either the database Alma owned by Åbo Akademi University or the archive's database (Spegeln/ Dokumenttyp: "Nottryck"), many also only in card catalog.
- arranged according to composer and work, A-Ö.

#### *II Foreign music* (218 RM)

- no catalog of this collection
- sorted according to ensemble category, composer and work, A-Ö

### 6. MUSIC LIBRARY OF THE MUSICAL SOCIETY OF TURKU

- The oldest music library of Finland. Contains many unique pieces from the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> century, etc. (26 RM)
- The oldest music is registered in the databases Alma and Spegeln (Document type: "Musikaliska Sällskapetets bibliotek"), whereas the newer music is registered in a card catalog.

### 7. SOUND RECORDINGS

#### *I Records*

- a) Gramophone records (78 rpm)
- b) Vinyl records (33 & 45 rpm)
- c) CDs

#### *II Cassette tapes, magnetic reel tapes*

#### *III Phonograph cylinders, pianola rolls etc.*

- The bulk of the sound recordings are registered in the online database Spegeln. (Spegeln/ SmL; 16156 posts as of 30.12.2014)

### 8. POSTERS

- the posters are registered in Spegeln (Spegeln / SmP: "Poster"; 1951 posts as of 31.12.2014)



Apart from the above mentioned the archive also owns separate special collections, e.g. on Jean Sibelius, Otto Andersson, Erik Bergman etc.
